OUR MISSON & PURPOSE

Heart of Agnes Community Association Inc. is a NfP asset, owned and operated by the people of the Agnes Water regional community.

Heart of Agnes is an Incorporated, Not-for-Profit platform developed to foster local partnerships and collaboration among community members. It is a meeting place for local connection and support; a launchpad for building ideas, and a tool for working more effectively as a Community body with Council, Industry and Govenement.

Heart of Agnes is not a traditional organisation... it is a platform for our community to GET ORGANISED.

Community Spirit in Action!

We support everyone in Agnes Water to engage in common good works that benefit themselves, their families and the wider community.

Our Constitution states our objectives:

- 1. To foster the values of fellowship, citizenship and good neighborship among the Agnes Water regional community.
- 2. To represent the Agnes Water regional community with integrity, honesty, creativity and leadership.
- 3. To develop and maintain an accurate demographic profile of the Agnes Water regional community through regular consultation and effective feedback mechanisms.
- 4. To serve the Agnes Water regional community through strategic, responsive, cost-effective initiatives that meet identified local need through evidence-based approaches.
- 5. To identify and build local partnerships and opportunities for collaboration among all stakeholders of the Agnes Water regional community.
- 6. To promote the many talents, skills, resources and opportunities in the Agnes Water regional community.
- 7. To support initiatives that strengthen cultural harmony and equality across the Agnes Water regional community.
- 8. To protect the Agnes Water regional community in its future growth through effective and united local leadership, strategic use of live data, and consistent representation at key planning meetings.
- 9. To establish the Agnes Water regional community as an independent, self-sufficient services hub, with an independent interagency network and shared resources and referral pathways among local services.



OUR HISTORY

The Heart of Agnes initiative emerged organically during the height of covid in 2021, with many residents concerned at the tension and polarisation occurring in our small community. A concern for civil rights, along with a flood of new population from urban areas contributed to a period of upheaval as the local culture experienced a radical shift, and the pressures on housing and essential services rapidly increased.

As a natural response, community members from within the Agnes Water region began to connect and engage in action together; expressing a strong desire to *maintain* a positive social cohesion, while building upon our independence, resilience and prosperity as a local community.

A network of heart-centred, skilled residents, collaborating through agreement on important bodies of strategic local work to support our whole community while protecting our environment. Heart of Agnes was born.

Our formation year was a dozen individuals, gathered closely around learning and sharing resources. We spent a long time LISTENING to community. Engaging with EVERYBODY; including our outter communities. Our leaders, our visitors, our organisations and businesses. So that is where we began, and how we set our course; as a coordinated, grassroots response to locally-identified need.

Creating an original Not-for-Profit resourcing model rather than a traditional community organisation was a risky move in a rural Queensland town at the height of covid. The initiative was not without its early doubters; who were already in a state of heightened reactivity due to the social climate, and challenged by the unconventional approach to community development.

In strategic response, the first major project for HOACA was the *Biggest Community Survey for the Agnes Water Region*, delivered in 2022. With over 530 contributors from across Southern Gladstone, the research produced a detailed snapshot of the community's views on a wide range of topics and important issues for the area. Using this body of work to inform the direction of HOACA; the platform has since empowered many other community members to deliver local projects, events and initiatives that continue to measurably contribute to the overall wellbeing of the Agnes Water community.

OUR GOVERNANCE & OPERATIONS

Heart of Agnes Community Association Inc. is an Incorporated Association (IA# 4613613) (ABN 41 400 987 085) and a Not-for-Profit platform developed to foster collaboration among community members in response to identified local need. The Association has a Constitution and is governed by a committee (Stewards) with a President, Secretary, Treasurer and general Members.

Heart of Agnes is not a traditional closed "organisation", but a *community asset*, owned and operated by the people of the Agnes Water regional community. All members of the community may access the platform through direct membership:

Members support eachother's good works in the local community by lending their own time, skills, funds and resources to see these initiatives succeed. Everything Heart of Agnes achieves is the result of collaboration and local community partnerships.

Through its Incorporation status, the HOACA platform allows all paying community members to access grants, networks, and resources for their projects. The platform encourages leadership, creativity, collaboration and practical action at a grassroots level. Its Incorporation status also provides members the opportunity to gain community credentials such as Blue Card, First Aid and Mental Health First Aid, community induction training and volunteer insurance.



TREASURER'S REPORT

Treasurers Report.

What another remarkable 12 months it has been for the Heart of Agnes platform!

We have grown a lot this year through the projects our members have developed and engaged in; attracting new friends, partners and sponsors to support local good works for the Agnes community.

Community Feast continues to be a huge success, welcoming families from around the region and helping so many through the resources it provides. And our Mobi-Mat which has been such a gift for so many people. To hear about how initiatives like these mean so much to people is the reason we do what we do, and I look forward to being part of more of the same over the next 12 months!

This year we received incredible financial support from the local business community, without whom we could not have achieved any of what we have. From our Mobi-Mat fundraiser to a donated Water Tank to support a local family struck by cancer, the generosity of our businesses one again shone through. We also received \$22,058 in funding through Gladstone Regional Council to support projects including the Time Capsule Documentary Morning Tea, Dandyman tour and Youth Calendar.

In the 2023-24 financial year we closed with a net balance of \$6,965 across our 4 accounts. This includes GRC Grassroots funds of \$6,865 dedicated to First Aid and MHFA training to be delivered later this year. Membership provided \$420 over the year from a total of 22 members; less than last year as a result of fewer public events.

I'm excited for the launch of our Youth Calendar next month and other new projects commencing in 2025. HOACA Inc. continues to growth in strength and sustainability; a true demonstration of community Spirit in action!



DISCOVERY COAST BIOSPHERE RESERVE

A key proposal raised by community through our consultation is Biosphere Reserve classification for the Discovery Coast. This would support the long term conservation and management of our National Parks as well as Lady Musgrave Island.

HOACA is currently exploring this proposal along with Gladstone Conservation Council and Discovery Coast Environmental Group.

INDEPENDENT AUDIT REPORT TO THE MEMBERS OF THE HEART OF AGNES COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION INC.

Scope

I have audited the attached Statement of Financial Position and Statement of Financial Performance for the year ended 30 June 2024. The Association's Management Committee is responsible for the preparation and presentation of the financial report and the information contained therein and has determined that the accounting policies used are consistent with the financial reporting requirements of the entity's constitution and are appropriate to meet the needs of the members. I have conducted an independent audit of the financial report in order to express an opinion to the members of the Heart of Agnes Community Association Inc. on its preparation and presentation. No opinion is expressed as to whether the accounting policies used are appropriate to the needs of the members.

The financial report has been prepared for distribution to members for the purpose of fulfilling the Management Committee's financial reporting requirements under the Association's constitution. I disclaim any assumption of responsibility for any reliance on this report or on the financial report to which it relates to any person other than the members, or for any purpose other than that for which it was prepared.

My audit has been conducted in accordance with Australian Auditing Standards. My procedures included examination of evidence supporting the amounts and other disclosures in the financial report. These procedures have been undertaken to form an opinion as to whether, in all material respects, the financial report is presented fairly in accordance with the cash basis of accounting whereby revenue is recorded when it is received, expenses are recorded when they are paid, and no assets or liabilities, other than cash, bank balances and fixed assets, are recorded. Statements of Accounting Concepts and Accounting Standards are not applicable to the cash basis of accounting adopted by the Heart of Agnes Community Association Inc.

The audit opinion expressed in this report has been formed on the above basis.

Qualifications

As is common for organisations of this type, it is not practicable for the Heart of Agnes Community Association Inc. to maintain an effective system of internal control over donations, memberships and other like fund-raising activities until their initial entry in the accounting records. Accordingly, my audit in relation to fund raising was limited to amounts recorded.

Qualified Audit Opinion

In my opinion, subject to the effects of such adjustments, if any, as might have been determined to be necessary had the limitations discussed in the qualification not existed, the financial report presents fairly in accordance with the cash basis of accounting, as described above, the transactions of the Heart of Agnes Community Association Inc for the year ended 30 June 2024 and of the financial position as at the end of that year.
